This scholarship, established in memory of Barry McDougall, B.A., LL.B., by his family, enables one Polish law graduate per year to travel to Canada to earn a Master of Laws degree (LL.M) the University of Ottawa.

An expert in energy law, Barry McDougall dedicated a great deal of his professional and personal life to making Canadian law accessible to people in Eastern and Central Europe.

#### Level of Scholarship

Graduate Level (LL.M.)

#### Eligibility Criteria

- Hold a *Magister* in Law, with a minimum average of “B” (70%) or its equivalent
- Be fluent in either French or English

#### Application Procedure

Each scholarship candidate must submit the following documentation for consideration:

- A completed scholarship application form;
- Official transcripts covering all previous university studies with English or French translation;
- A curriculum vitae;
- Two (2) typed letters of support from academic sources;
- A personal statement of why you are applying;
- A description of your proposed research topic;
- Proof of proficiency in English (TOEFL).
